Here is the last-minute information to ensure your smooth arrival to Sokos Hotel Presidentti on Thursday or Friday. We are all set to go with this important weekend, and we are looking forward to seeing you in sunny Helsinki later this week.

The important places

The 2022 WRRC General Meeting weekend takes place at Original Sokos Hotel Presidentti (A), located downtown Helsinki, close to the Helsinki Central Railway Station (B), the House of Parliament and the Kamppi shopping mall. The Saturday night dinner takes place at a close distance, at Restaurant 10th Floor, a functional classic operating on the roof of Hotel Vaakuna (C).

There are many restaurants and cafeterias nearby, as the hotel is at the very centre of Helsinki.

How to get here

The closest international airport is Helsinki Airport (HEL), located in Vantaa, 18 km north from the venue. Taking a taxi outside the terminal building is easy, just follow the exit and taxi signs at your arrival terminal. We recommend taking a **Taksi Helsinki lane 2** ride with a fixed price of EUR 35 from terminal to the venue. Taking a HSL commuter train from the airport to the Helsinki Central Railway station through the heart-shaped track is also convenient. You can take either I-train or P-train and they both arrive to the Central Railway Station, which is located within a walking distance (500 m) from the venue. The train station is located between terminals 1 and 2 at the airport, and you can enter the train station without going outside the terminal building, just follow the signs at the airport.



An ABC-single ticket for an adult at a ticket machine costs EUR 4,10. The trains depart at about every ten to twenty minutes. It takes about 40-45 minutes by train from the airport to the Helsinki Central Railway Station and it is less than a 10-minute walk from the railway station to the venue.
